ICT USER AGREEMENT

Students need to sign the agreement before they get access to the school network. We updated the student agreement in November 2019 to include:

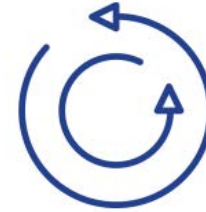
